To: Graduating Blue Ribbon Winners at the Kiwanis-Ogeechee Fair

In honor of deceased Club members, the Kiwanis Club of Statesboro, Georgia again intends to award the Kiwanis Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$2,000. This scholarship may be used only to assist in expenses incurred while attending a four-year college or university. The scholarship will be awarded based on academic achievement, extra-curricular activities (related to school, church, and/or community), and the applicant's fair entry.

To be eligible, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Graduate this year from a high school in one of the following counties: Bryan, Bulloch, Candler, Evans, Jenkins, Screven, or Tatnall.
- Submitted a judged entry that won a blue ribbon at one of the three most recent Kiwanis-Ogeechee Fairs. (Visual proof is required.)

The club's Scholarship Committee invites applications from any student who meets these criteria. To apply, complete a copy of the form on the back of this sheet, enclose all requested materials, mail to the address shown below. (The only exception is the recommendation letter, which must be sent by the writer directly to the committee.) All applications must be postmarked before midnight on July 18 of this year.

Winners will be announced and recognized at a club meeting in the near future. The Kiwanis Club of Statesboro will transmit \$2,000 to the financial aid offices of the winners' educational institutions. These funds will be deposited in the students' accounts and applied to academic expenses incurred during their first year.
